INFORMATION: Sheriff Pat Whiteford reports that Kalkaska County Sheriff's Deputies took a report of the breaking and entering of the Citgo Station in the Village of Kalkaska on 9/8/16 and again on 10/3/16. Both incidents involved windows being broken out to gain entry. Cigarettes were stolen on 9/8/16 and on 10/3/16 both cigarettes and liquor were taken.

No suspects have been arrested on any of the incidents thus far. There is no indication that these breaking and entering's are related to the other larcenies from motor vehicles that have occurred recently in Kalkaska County.

The Kalkaska Sheriff's Office, Michigan State Police and Kalkaska Village Department of Public Safety have been working together providing extra patrols of these areas to ensure safety of the businesses and property of the citizens of Kalkaska County.
