The Kalkaska Sheriff's Office has partnered up with the Kalkaska Village Department of Public Safety, Kalkaska Village Department of Public Works, The Kalkaska Village President, Kalkaska District and Probate Court, Kalkaska County Treasurer's Office, Kalkaska County Clerk's Office and Kalkaska County Register of Deed's Office to raise money for winter wear for Kalkaska's kids. In conjunction with "No Shave November" the agencies will allow a "hair down" policy for the Uniformed Divisions and a "wear jeans to work" for the Administrative positions during the months of November and December.

In determining the recipient of the funds raised by these agencies, we contacted Forest Area and Kalkaska Public Schools to determine if there was a need for winter boots for disadvantaged children within the school system. Both schools agreed that this is a worthy cause which would benefit many children.

Our plan is to team up with a local business and purchase as many pair of boots as our funds will allow. As of today, we have raised over \$1,300.00 which should give us a good start to ensuring our community kids have proper outdoor attire.
